## **ESTONIA**

**Estonia continued for some years to live in the shadow of its powerful neighbour, Russia, following the collapse of the Soviet Union.**

**It took two historic and decisive steps out of this shadow in the final months of 2002 when it was invited to join NATO at the Prague summit and the EU at the Copenhagen summit. Estonians gave strong backing to EU membership when they voted in a referendum in September 2003 and the country is now set to join in 2004.**
